

# Torreon Golf Course Update

Dear Members & Friends,

The Men's Member Guest Tournament went well! The golf course was in good shape for the festivities.

We continue to find efficiencies in our process and learned several new tactics for timely prepping of the golf course. Hopefully everyone enjoyed themselves and plans to participate in the 2011 Men's Member Guest.

The ponds are near the top of our priority list. We have ordered an aerifier for #12 Cabin to circulate the water and introduce the necessary oxygen into the system. Through the monsoon season, they have been relatively undisturbed resulting in a stagnant situation. Much of the water's oxygen was depleted, which speeds the organic material rotting process on the bottom. With the new aerifier continually supplying oxygen this shouldn't happen in the future. The unit will be in place by the end of next week.

Everyone has probably noticed the digging around the chipping green. We suspect a leak in the water line that completes the waterfall feature system. Once the leak is fixed, the area will be repaired. In the meantime, we ask for your patience.

Our monsoon season continues to roll on. We're doing our best to minimize irrigation use. We monitor the program closely and ramp-up the irrigation when necessary. At one point, we went nearly 3 weeks without nightly watering.

We are reasonably happy with the way the course handles the heavy rains. As new drainage issues are identified, they will be repaired.

Please continue fixing ball marks and sanding divots.
